



## Skagit County Canopy Regulations

Permits: Chapter 31, specifically 3103.2 Approval required

Tents or membrane structures 400 square feet or more require a permit to be erected and used. The exception to the rule: if the tent is open on all sides than a permit is not require unless the tent is 700 square feet or larger.

Permits for tents are \$50.00 to \$100.00 depending on use.

We require a site plan with dimensions and an explanation of the use to determine code requirements.

The maximum time a tent can be erected is 180 days

Location and access: 3103.8

Tents or membrane structures shall not be located within 20 feet of lot lines, buildings, other tents or membrane structures, parked vehicles or internal combustion engines.

3103.9 Anchorage required

Tents or membrane structures and their appurtenances shall be adequately roped, braced and anchored to withstand the elements of weather and prevent against collapsing. Manufacturers anchoring requirements to be provided with site plan.

Prohibited uses: 3104.15.5 MVMC

Cooking where grease laden vapors are produced is prohibited under any tent or membrane structure. The exception to the rule is the cooking appliances are protected by an approved Type I hood and suppression system.
